National Institutes of Health Funding for New Mexico¹

- In FY2016, New Mexico received 218 NIH-funded grants through normal appropriations process, totaling \$99,743,752.
- This represents an increase of \$9.2 million from FY2015 and 26 more grants.

National Science Foundation Funding for New Mexico²

• In FY2016, NSF provided 172 awards totaling over \$51.8 million.

NIH Helping Communities

What does NIH funding mean for the New Mexico economy?


- In FY2007, each NIH dollar invested in New Mexico generated \$1.95 in new state business activity³.
- In FY2016, the NIH supported \$239 million in economic activity and 1,531 jobs⁴.

Life Science Industry Impact⁵

- 36,300 individuals are employed directly in life science jobs.
- The average annual wage for life sciences jobs is 86,400.
