Glance New York



National Institutes of Health Funding for new York¹

- In FY2016, New York received 4,953 NIH-funded grants through normal appropriations process, totaling \$2,205,949,608.
- This represents an increase of \$159,121,671 from FY2015 and 79 more grants.

National Science Foundation Funding for New York²

• In FY2016, NSF provided 1,529 awards totaling over \$480 million.

NIH Helping Communities

What does NIH funding mean for the New York economy?


- In FY2007, each NIH dollar invested in New York generated \$2.02 in new state business activity³.
- In FY2016, the NIH supported \$5.477 billion in economic activity and 27,526 jobs⁴.

Life Science Industry Impact⁵

- 36,300 individuals are employed directly in life science jobs.
- The average annual wage for life sciences jobs is 86,400.
