National Institutes of Health Funding for Pennsylvania¹

- In FY2016, Pennsylvania received 3,464 NIH-funded grants through normal appropriations process, totaling \$1,570,151,520.
- This represents an increase of \$69.8 million from FY2015 and 101 more grants.

National Science Foundation Funding for Pennsylvania²

• In FY2016, NSF provided 1,033 awards totaling over \$275 million.

NIH Helping Communities

What does NIH funding mean for the Pennsylvania economy?


- In FY2007, each NIH dollar invested in Pennsylvania generated \$2.32 in new state business activity³.
- In FY2016, the NIH supported \$3.974 billion in economic activity and 21,751 jobs⁴.

Life Science Industry Impact⁵

- 36,300 individuals are employed directly in life science jobs.
- The average annual wage for life sciences jobs is 86,400.
