

Biomedical Research Funding-at-a-Glance **Mississippi**



National Institutes of Health Funding for Mississippi¹

- In FY2016, Mississippi received 89 NIH-funded grants through normal appropriations process, totaling \$53,538,828.
- This represents an increase of \$5,795,118 from FY2015 and the same number of grants.

National Science Foundation Funding for Mississippi²

- In FY2016, NSF provided 76 awards totaling over \$32 million.

NIH Helping Communities

What does NIH funding mean for the Mississippi economy?

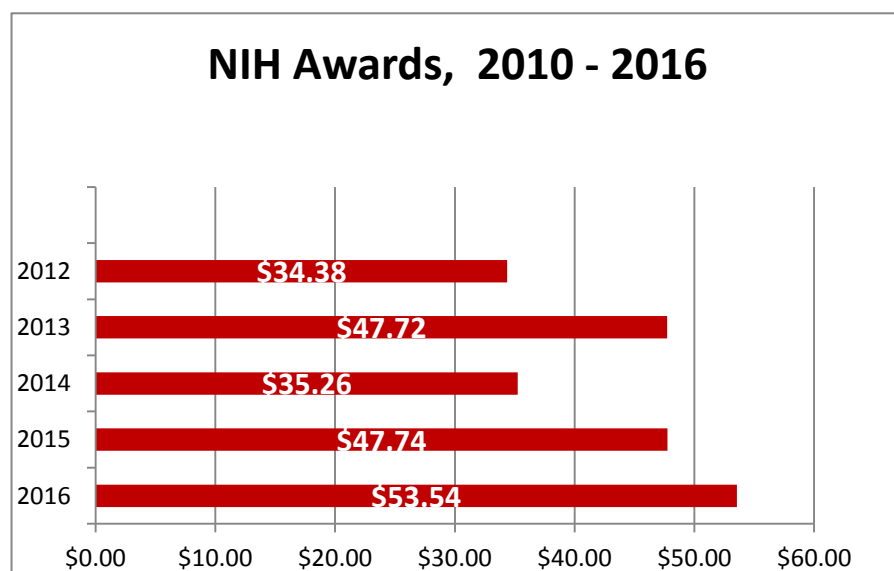
- In FY2007, each NIH dollar invested in Mississippi generated \$1.90 in new state business activity³.
- In FY2016, the NIH supported \$157.8 million in economic activity and 1,121 jobs⁴.

Life Science Industry Impact

- In 2014, Mississippi was home to 458 bioscience businesses.
- 6,425 individuals are employed directly in life science jobs⁵.
- The average annual wage for life sciences jobs in 2016 was \$25,150⁷.
