

# Biomedical Research Funding-at-a-Glance **Wyoming**



## National Institutes of Health Funding for Wyoming<sup>1</sup>

- In FY2016, Wyoming received 15 NIH-funded grants through normal appropriations process, totaling over \$9,477,709.

## National Science Foundation Funding for Wyoming<sup>2</sup>

- In FY2015, NSF provided 37 awards totaling over \$13 thousand.

## NIH Helping Communities

### What does NIH funding mean for the Wyoming economy?

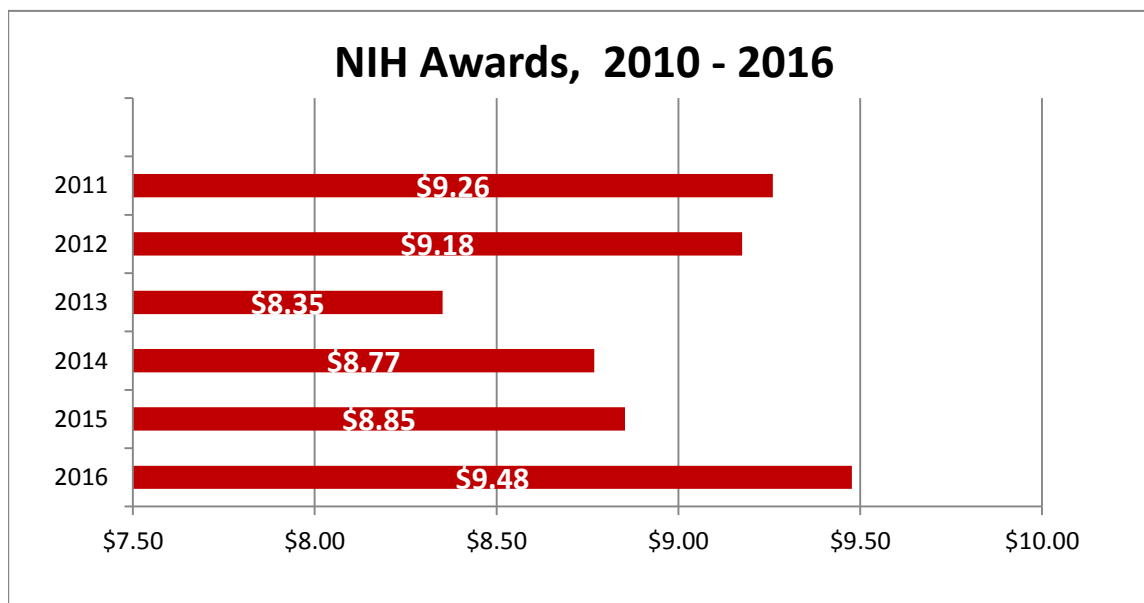
- In FY2007, each NIH dollar invested in Wyoming generated \$1.71 in new state business activity<sup>3</sup>.
- In FY2015, the NIH supported \$39.4 million in economic activity and 266 jobs<sup>4</sup>.

### Life Science Industry Impact<sup>5</sup>

- The life science industry in Wyoming is home to 130 bioscience businesses.
- 945 individuals are employed directly in life science jobs.
- The average annual wage for life sciences jobs is 50,000.
